- Electives are selected for the full reporting period and changes during this period are not permitted, unless clearly justified on educational grounds. Students are allowed the first 2 weeks of the term to come to a decision before finally committing themselves for the rest of the reporting period. A Change of Elective form must be completed in full and approved by the Assistant Head, Academics before any changes can be made.
- Apart from Theatre Arts and Instrumental Performance, numbers are limited to 24 and allocations will be made on a first come, first served basis. The school holds the right to assign students to alternate options should the maximum number of students within any elective subject be reached.
- All elective courses are subject to enrolment of at least 10 students, scheduling requirements and available resources.
