

Mulgrave Junior School Awards (Grade 3 to 6)

Mulgrave is proud to recognise the efforts and achievements of students over the year at an evening awards ceremony in June. The purpose of this event is to recognise and celebrate the successes of our students, and foster a caring and supportive community. To determine which students are recognised in this ceremony, teachers meet in the late spring to nominate candidates whom they feel meet the award criteria. Students who have been suspended or have been placed under conduct probation during the current academic year are not eligible to receive any of the major awards in that given year.

Below is a listing of some of the awards that may be presented.

MULGRAVE Award (up to two per class): This is awarded to students who have scored highly in each of the attributes associated with the award: M-anners, U-niqueness, L-ove of learning, G-enerosity, R-espect, A-ttitude, V-erve, and E-xcellence

Effort Award (one per class): This is awarded to the student who has put a consistently high level of effort into academics, the arts, athletics or service, or a combination of those strands.

Spirit Award (one per class): This is awarded to the student who motivates, leads, and inspires and who is positive and inclusive. The manifestation of these qualities may vary depending on the age of the student.

Madat E Jamal Award: This award is presented to a student who has displayed outstanding aesthetic awareness and creativity in the visual arts.

Koenig Family Award: This is awarded for Fine Arts and performance.

Violet Witty Memorial Award: This is presented to a student who has displayed perseverance throughout the year.

Everett Allan Larose Memorial Award for Positiveness: This is awarded to the student who most exemplifies a positive attitude towards self, fellow students and faculty.

Dynapro Cup: This is awarded to the student who expresses a genuine interest in inquiry as it relates to scientific topics an experimental process.

Stanley Ross Mitchell Memorial Award: This is awarded for excellent participation and achievement in school music activities.

George Woods Plate: This is awarded for spirit and enthusiasm – *put your heart into everything you do.*

Public Speaking Award: This is awarded for excellence in public speaking.

Priest Love of Learning Award: This is for the student who exemplifies the love of learning.

Andrew Lambert Award for Positive Action: This is awarded to the student who best demonstrated positive action in service for the betterment of our environment or the people of our world.

The Alexander Grace Inspiration Award: Donated by the Solloway family as a tribute to a young life lost to cancer, this award recognizes the student who shows the qualities of perseverance, courage and dignity under adversity.

Male Athletic Award: This is awarded to the Junior School male student who displays leadership, sportsmanship and all around athleticism.

Female Athletic Award: This is awarded to the Junior School female student who displays leadership, sportsmanship and all around athleticism.

House Cup Trophy: This is presented to the House Captains of the winning House team.

Chairman's Cup: This award is in recognition of the Junior School student who exemplifies the combined attributes of citizenship, academics, the arts and athletics.
